

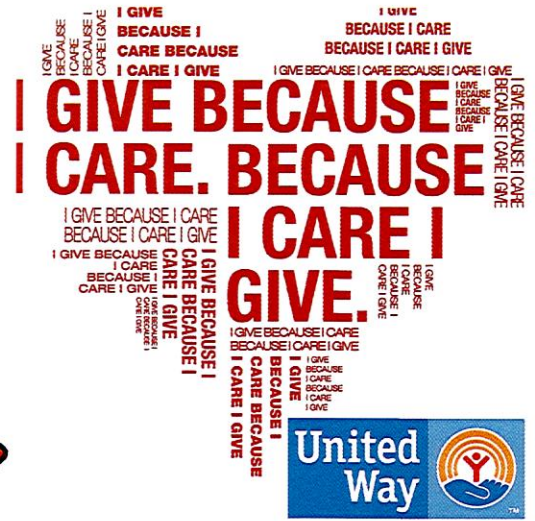
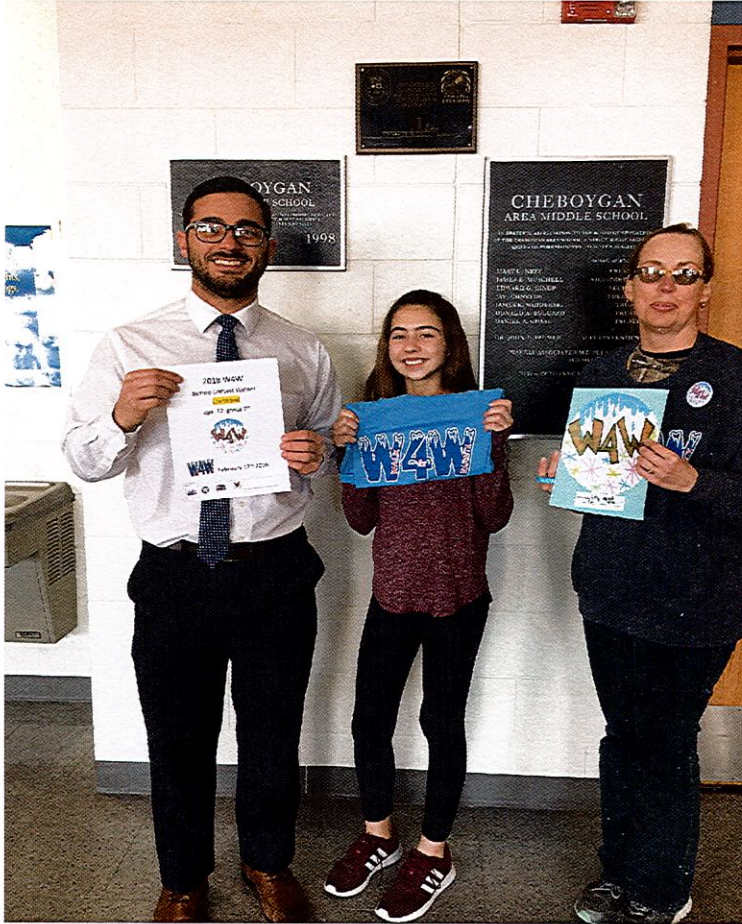
WALK 4 WARMTH
